JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE – By publication

This matter is before this Court on Plaintiff’s Petition for Dissolution of Marriage. Plaintiff is present in person, pro se. The Defendant has been served by publication, a copy of which has been filed with the Clerk of the Court for Sangamon County. Witness sworn and evidence heard. Based upon the testimony heard this Court FINDS AND ORDERS as follows:

1. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction over this matter, the Plaintiff having resided in Illinois for more than 90 days preceding the date of this Order.
2. Venue is proper, as the Plaintiff resides in Sangamon County, Illinois.
3. The Plaintiff does not know where the Defendant is located, and has exercised due diligence in attempting to locate the Defendant, without success.
4. The Plaintiff has properly served the Defendant by publication.
5. The Plaintiff and Defendant were married _____ in _____ County, _____, where the marriage was registered.
6. The Plaintiff and Defendant lived together as Husband and Wife until _____, at which time they separated.
7. _____ children were born to the marriage, who currently reside with _____, and who are as follows (give names and dates of birth of children):
8. No other children were born to the marriage, no children were adopted and the wife is not now pregnant.
9. _____ Irreconcilable differences have caused the irretrievable breakdown of the marriage, without cause or provocation by either party. The parties have attempted to reconcile those differences, without success, and future attempts to reconcile those differences would not be in the best interests of the family unit. Or
_____ Defendant has been guilty of extreme and repeated acts of mental cruelty, without cause or provocation on the part of the Plaintiff.

Based upon the foregoing, the court orders that the marriage of the Plaintiff and Defendant is dissolved. This is a final judgment reserving ruling on children, support, maintenance and property.
