

RESOLUTION 22-1


WHEREAS, Sangamon County (the County) desires to join in with the City of Springfield (the City) and the Illinois Department of Transportation (the State) in order to study the environmental impacts of public improvements to accommodate high speed rail and increased freight traffic that flows through the County; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (ILCS 5-220/1 *et seq.*) provide that units of government may contract or otherwise associate among themselves to obtain or share services; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the County to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the State and the City to study the environmental impacts of high speed rail.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Sangamon County, in session this 8th day of December, 2009, that the County Board hereby authorizes the County Board Chairman to sign, on behalf of the County, an intergovernmental agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation and the City of Springfield to study the environmental impact of public improvements to accommodate high speed rail and increased freight rail traffic that flows through the jurisdiction of the County.
